

ORDINANCE NO. 102

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF CLAYTON, IOWA BY
AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO OPEN BURNING**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clayton, Iowa, as follows:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 105.05, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Clayton, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

105.05 OPEN BURNING RESTRICTED. No person shall allow, cause or permit open burning of combustible materials where the products of combustion are emitted into the open air without passing through a chimney or stack, except that open burning is permitted in the following circumstances and must always be attended and have a fire extinguishment source at hand (water hose, fire extinguisher, shovel, sand, etc.):

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjunction shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and posting as provided by law.
